## General sales and property conditions

- All orders must be in a written form and- even if drawn up by our agents-are to be considered confirmed from us.
- Prices of our price list are not binding: we could make changes before accepting orders. Even if after an order confirmation, until the delivery, it is within our authority to make price changes, due to higher costs of raw materials, labor, fuel or production costs.

All payments must be made within the agreed terms directly to our bank account.

Any costs due to delayed payments or extended terms are at the buyer's expense.

For failure to respect terms of payment we reserve the right to suspend all further consignments of goods on order without any communication.

- Delivery dates are purely indicative , any eventual delay in delivery, interruption, total or partial suspension of supplies are not reason for indemnity or compensation of damages.
- Goods are delivered ex-factory.  
Our responsibility ends upon consignment of goods to driver, goods travel at the risk of the receiver and for this reason we do not accept claims for damaged or tampered goods. Eventual agreements with shipping agents, even if transports costs are included, are understood always to be concluded on behalf of the buyer and his name thus ratifying and accepting our actions.
- All goods remain at our property until payment has been fully effected.
- Guarantee against defects is limited to first choice goods and to quantities above the accepted allowance of 5%.

For goods of inferior choice we are not obliged to guarantee either quality or suitability. The obligation of guarantee commits us to the sole replacement of goods with the exclusive of any responsibility for damages-direct or indirect-suffered by the buyer and only if stone was used according to the Grebelsky

Stone manual. In any case this guarantee is limited to 3 years from date of bill of lading.

- Any eventual claim regarding quality, quantity, or type of material must reach us within 8 days of delivery date.

Buyers commit themselves to hold any claimed goods at our disposal, thus allowing us to control denounced defects.

- In all cases the laying of tiles exempts us from any responsibility as it is compulsory that products are controlled by the buyer before being put into use.
- No survey will be prompted on our materials if the decree of appointment of the expert does not come directly and beforehand to our offices allowing us enough time to be present during the expert's control. No defense of merit application will be promoted by the purchaser unless all the invoice costs for materials already collected have been entirely paid.
- For no reason may a buyer return goods without our written authorization. In case of strikes, closure, reduction or lack of raw materials, transport-problems, war, revolt, interruption of communications-whatever the reason-kilns out of or any other unforeseen event we reserve the right to suspend deliveries and even cancel orders without the buyers having any right to claim damages.
- The law-courts of Israel are exclusively responsible in handling any controversy or claim whatsoever.
